- Continued providing free recycling bags for the new yard waste recycling program
- Completed construction of the new Raw Water Storage Reservoir, which more than doubled our raw water storage capacity
- Commenced the Riverside Wetland Enhancement Project, which will create 3 wetlands on the golf course, amongst many other benefits of this project
- Completed construction of a new sewer main line through the golf course
- Completed the xeriscaping landscaping project in front of Town hall (north half)
- Continued with the sidewalk trip hazard removal program
- Completed the sewage lagoon de-sludging project
- Replaced 6 water main line valves throughout Town
- Raised \$2,467 for the Milk River Minor Baseball Association at the annual Town golf tournament
- Raised \$1,300 (\$650 for each school) at the 1st Annual Town Community Christmas party
- In partnership with the County of Warner, Town of Raymond and Villages of Coutts, Warner and Stirling, we received a grant to assist with developing the government mandated *Intermunicipal Collaborative Framework* for \$178,000
- In conjunction with the Village of Coutts, approved a Joint Municipality Water Conservation Bylaw.
