Delegations

Andrew Kleisinger, MPE Engineering Ltd., presented the tender results for the Booster Station Rehabilitation project, highlighting the reasoning for the project coming in over budget and the measures that have been taken to reduce the scope of the project to help reduce the overages.

Resolutions

#2019-09-06

Council approved increasing the Booster Station Rehabilitation Project to \$525,000 including GST and awarded the project to Parcon Construction Ltd.

#2019-09-07-08

Council first and second readings of Bylaw #1023 – Council Procedure Bylaw.

#2019-09-09-12

Council approved all three readings of Bylaw #1024 – Nuisance Bylaw. This will assist in the speediness of dealing with repeat offenders with regards to unsightly properties.

#2019-09-13

Council approved sending an advocacy letter to the Premier and Minister of Health regarding the HALO rescue services.

#2019-09-14

Council approved reducing the opening and closing fee for cremation burials at the cemetery.

#2019-09-15

Council approved increasing the yearly allocation for Policy F2.0 - Green Strip Credit, conditional upon a review of the program.

#2019-09-16

Council agreed to keep the ATCO Franchise fee at the same rate for 2020 as it was for 2019.

#2019-09-17

Council agreed to allow an extension to December 31, 2020 for the dwelling building requirement from the purchase of 950 Main Street (currently vacant land).

#2019-09-18

Council accepted the email from Mrs. Rey Richards, as information and directed administration to forward the email on to the Bonanza Days Committee for consideration.
