

BY-LAW 686

A BY-LAW OF THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILK RIVER, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 677 BEING A RECEDING BY-LAW.

WHEREAS, Section 109 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980, as amended, provides that a Council may repeal or amend any by-law; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Milk River deems it expedient to amend By-Law No. 677 being a by-law to Repeal Previously Passed By-Laws.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Milk River duly assembled enacts as follows:


1. THAT Schedule "A" of By-Law No. 677 hereby be amended to include the following:

" 346 Debenture - Sewage Treatment Facilities
Improvements
347 Debenture - Water System Improvements
425 Debenture - Purchase of Land
539 Debenture - Sewage Lagoon Improvements. "

2. THAT in all other respects By-Law No. 677 shall remain the same and in full force and effect.
